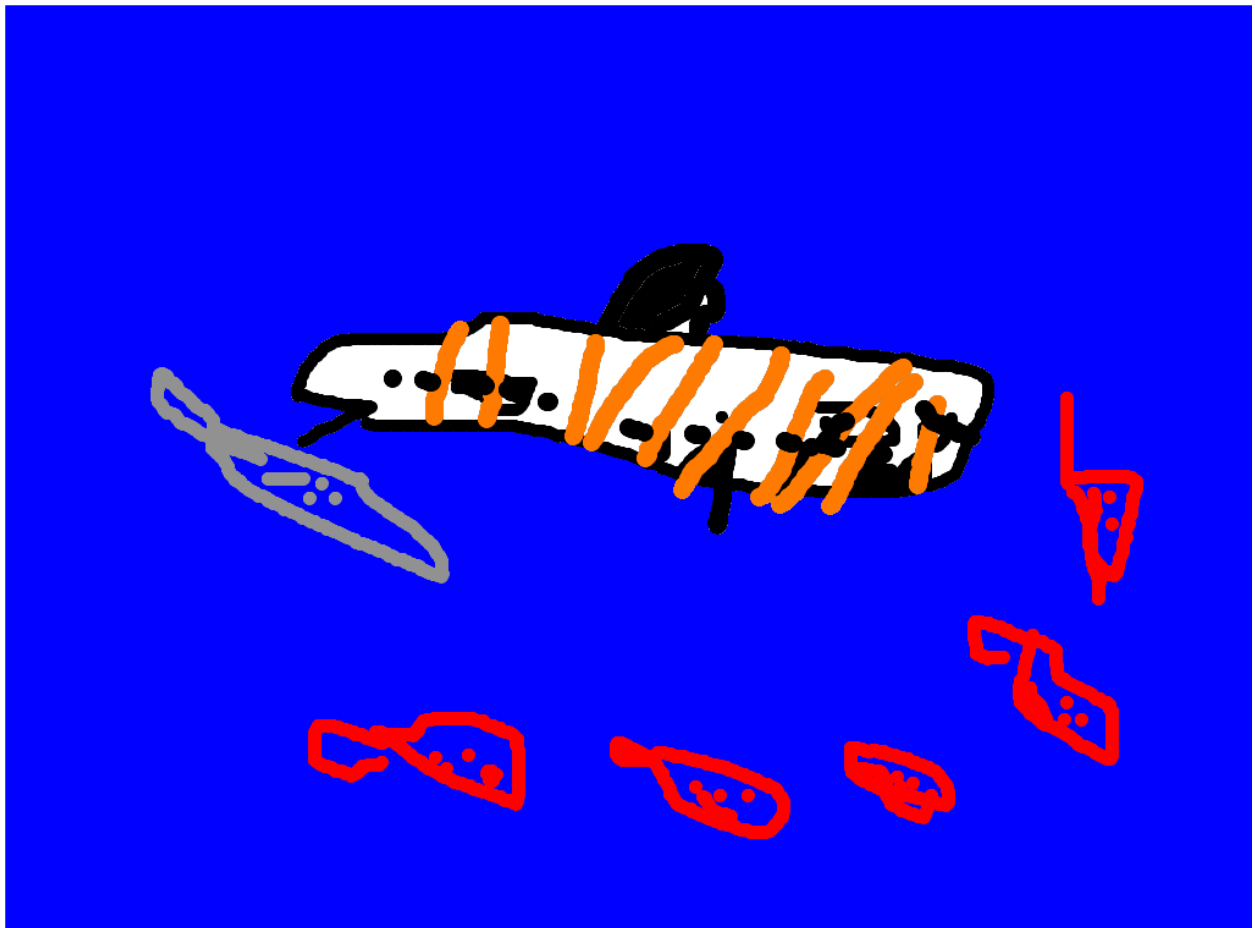
Amazing Shark

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is canaries are small, yellow songbirds that many people keep as pets. People enjoy their beautiful songs.



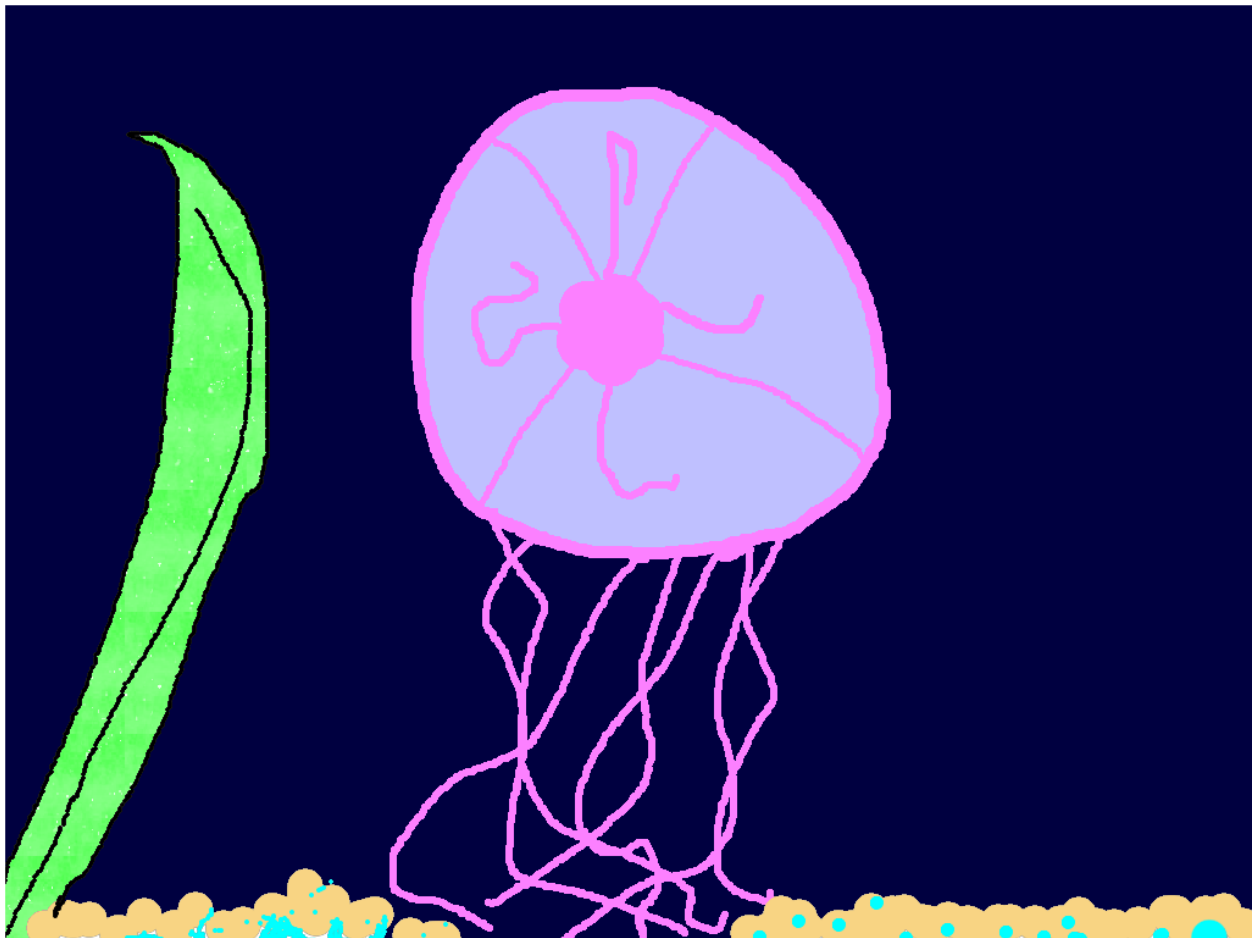
Amazing Jellyfish

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is a skunk sprays a bad smelling liquid when it is scared.



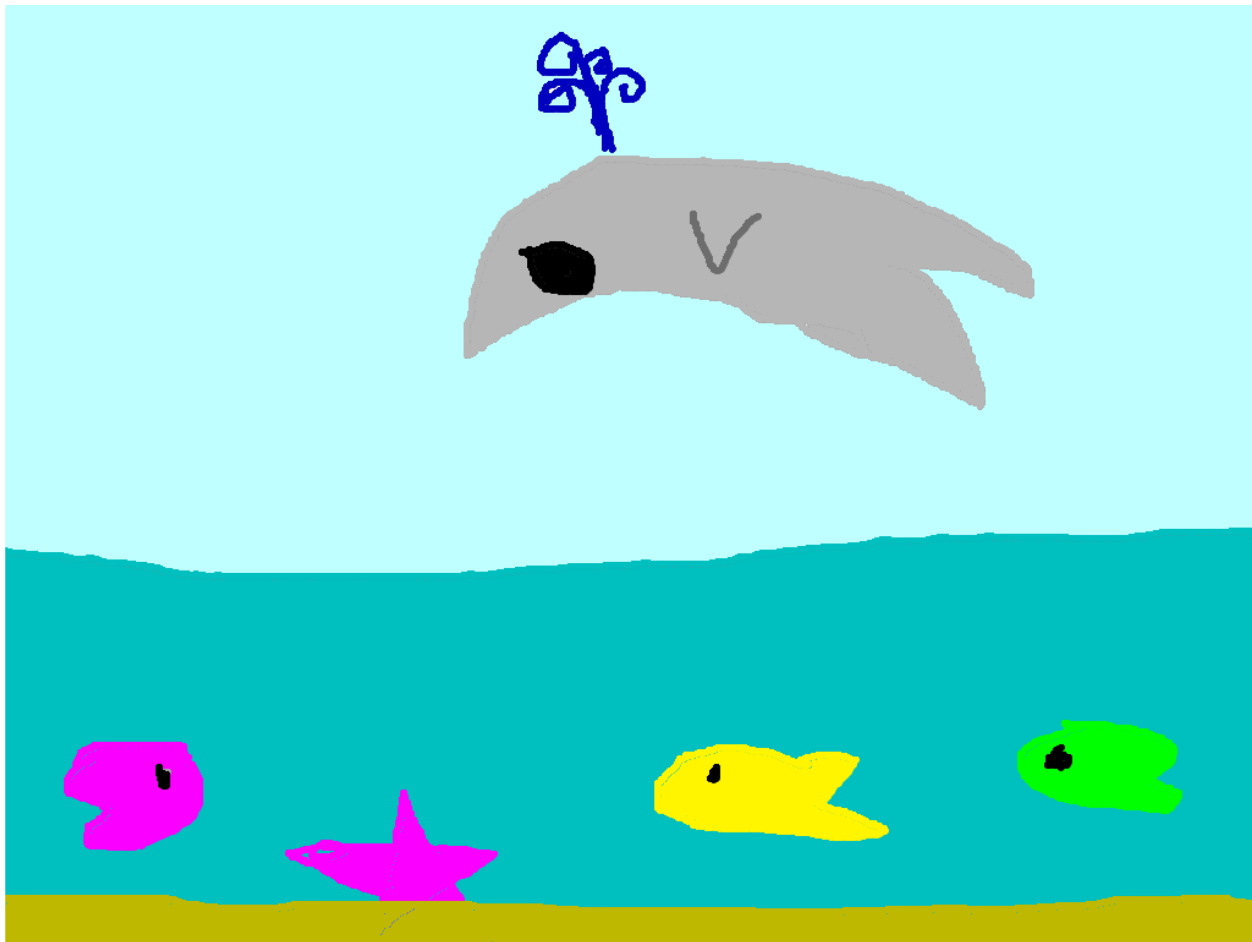
Amazing Dolphin

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is scientists believe dolphins are very intelligent animals.



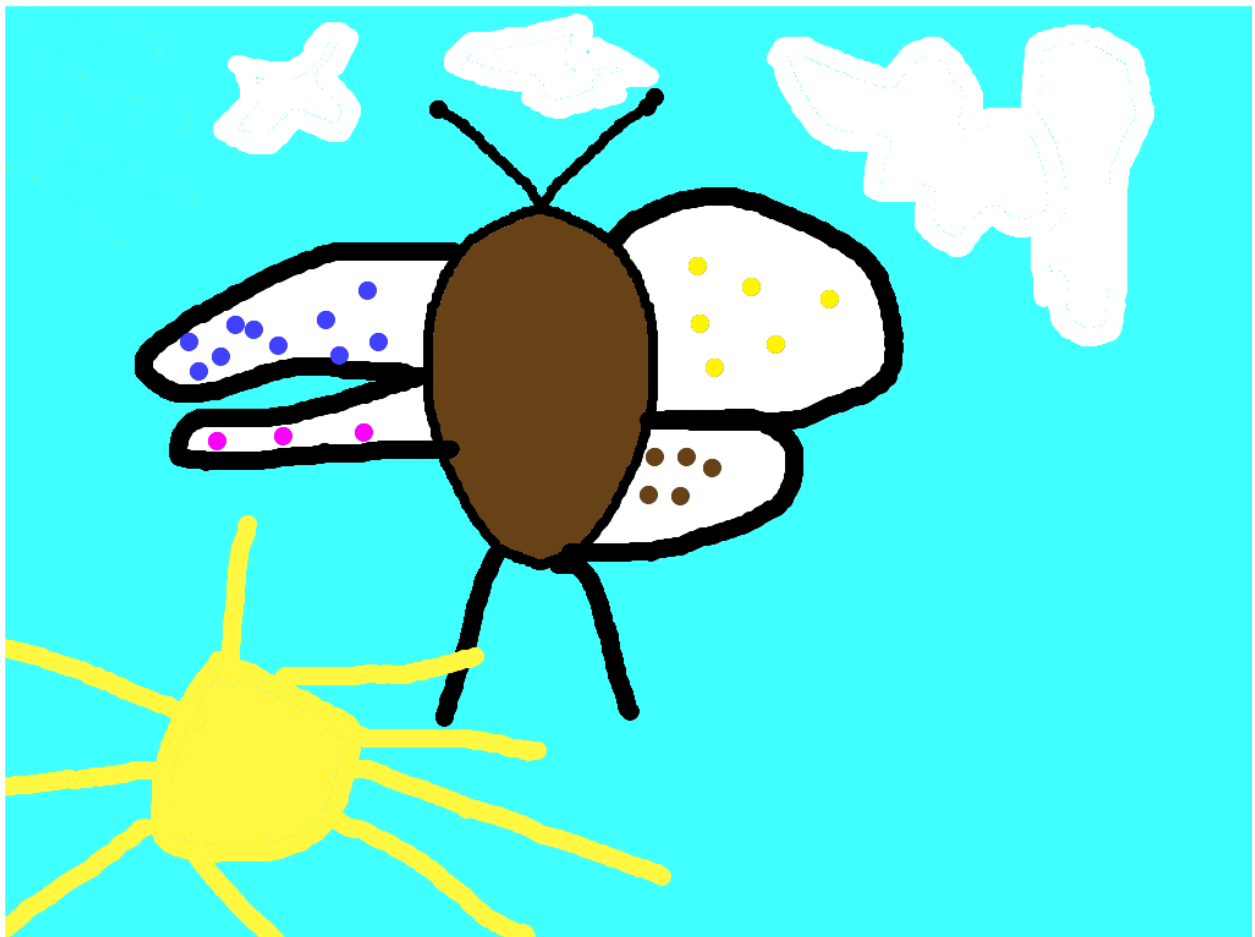
Amazing Butterfly

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is that there are thousands of kinds of flies.



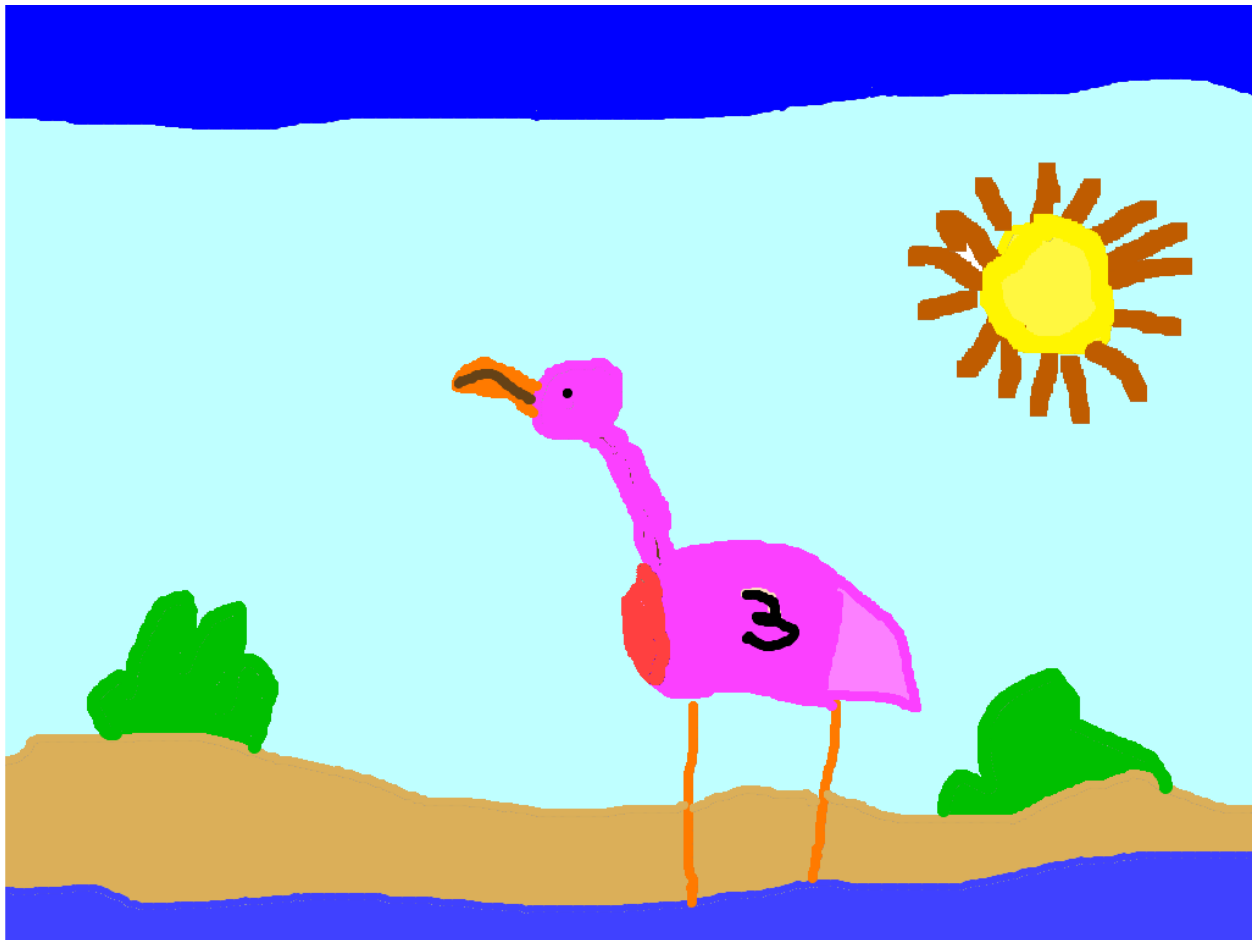
Amazing Flamingo

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is the eagle is one of the biggest and most powerful animals in the world.



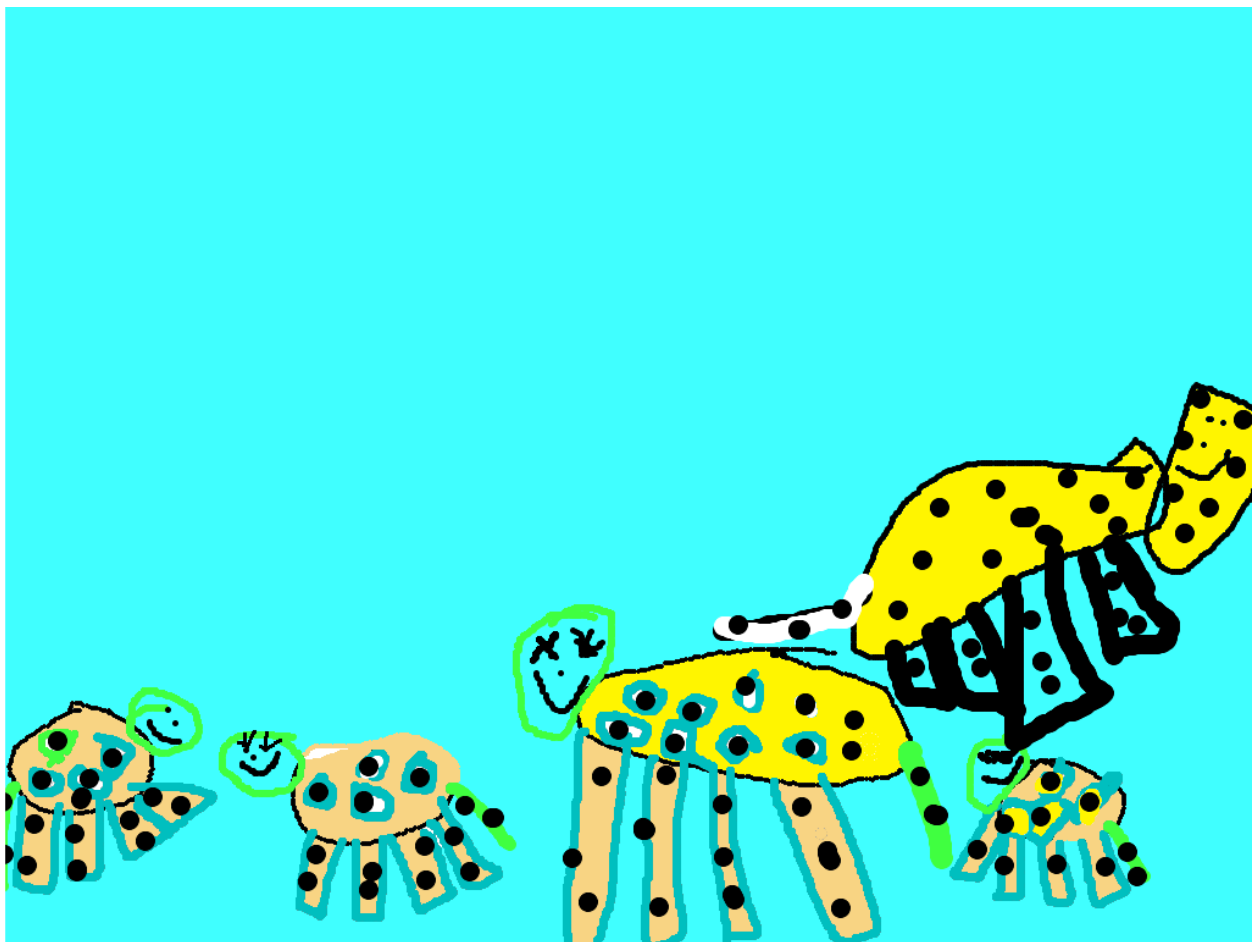
Amazing Leopard

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is leopards are good climbers and often carry the animals they kill up a tree.



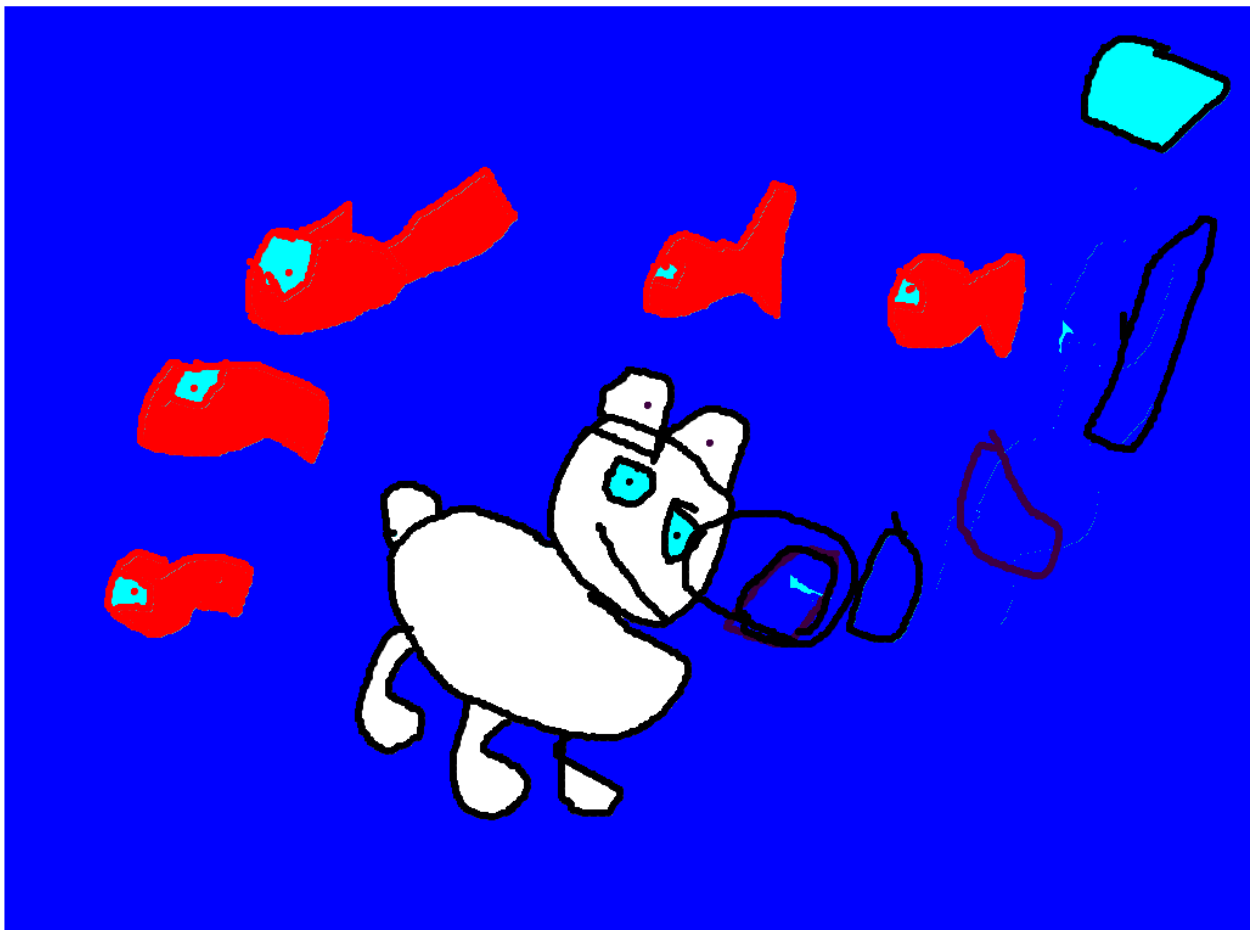
Amazing Polar Bear

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is polar bears have very thick fur and lots of layers of fat to protect them from the cold weather.



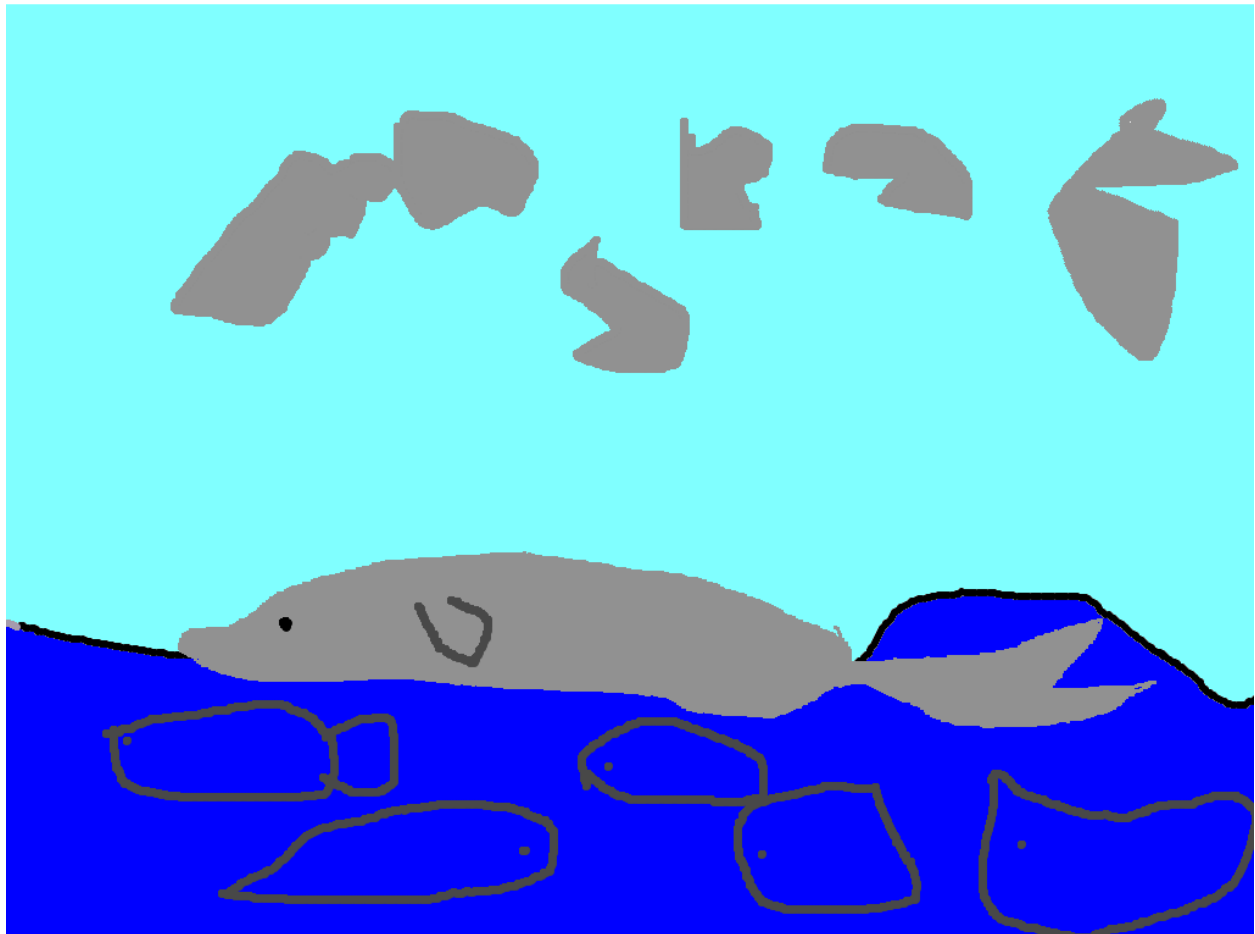
Amazing Whale

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is the whale looks like a fish, but it is a mammal.



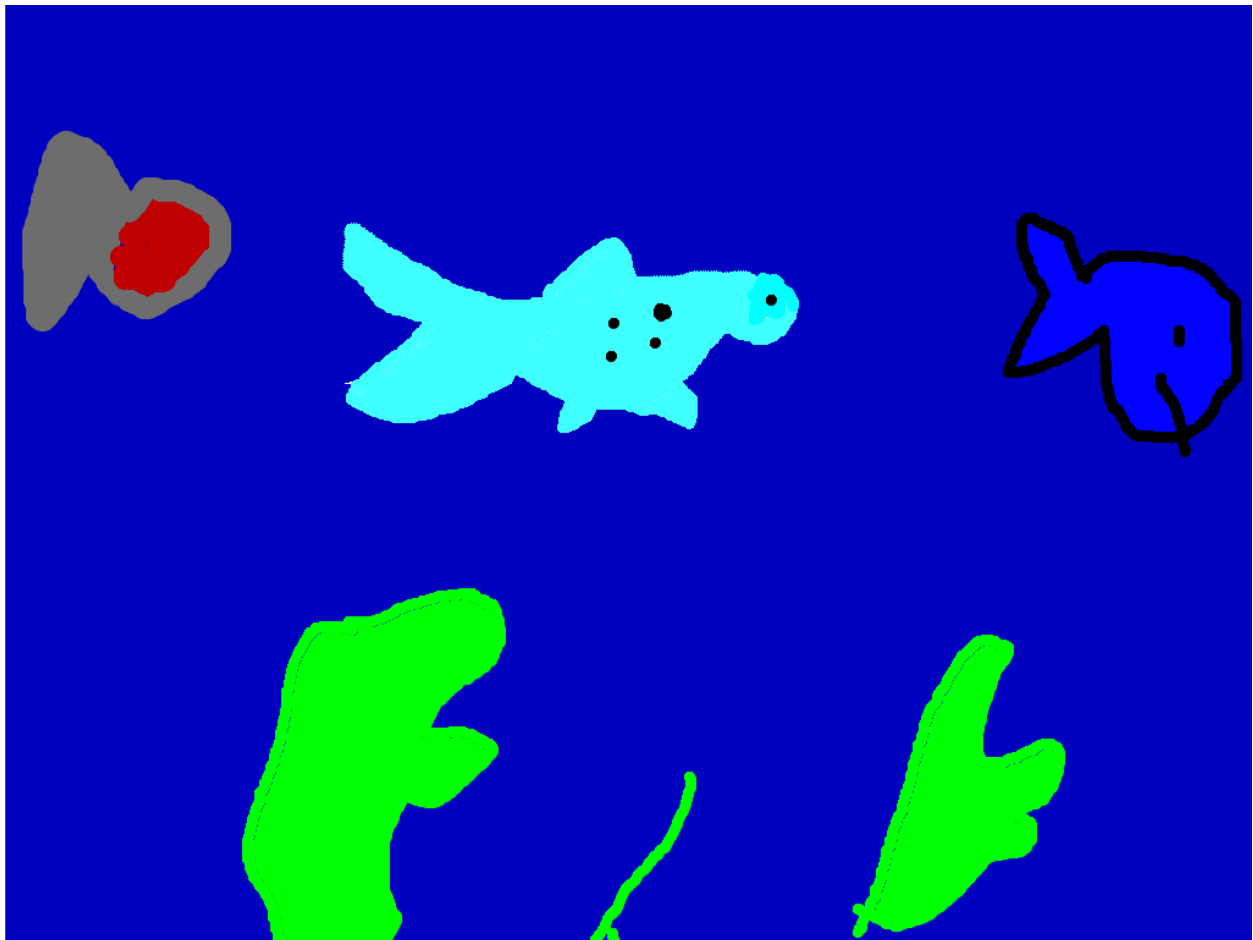
Amazing Dolphin

An interesting fact about my amazing animal is there are hundreds of kinds of rays.



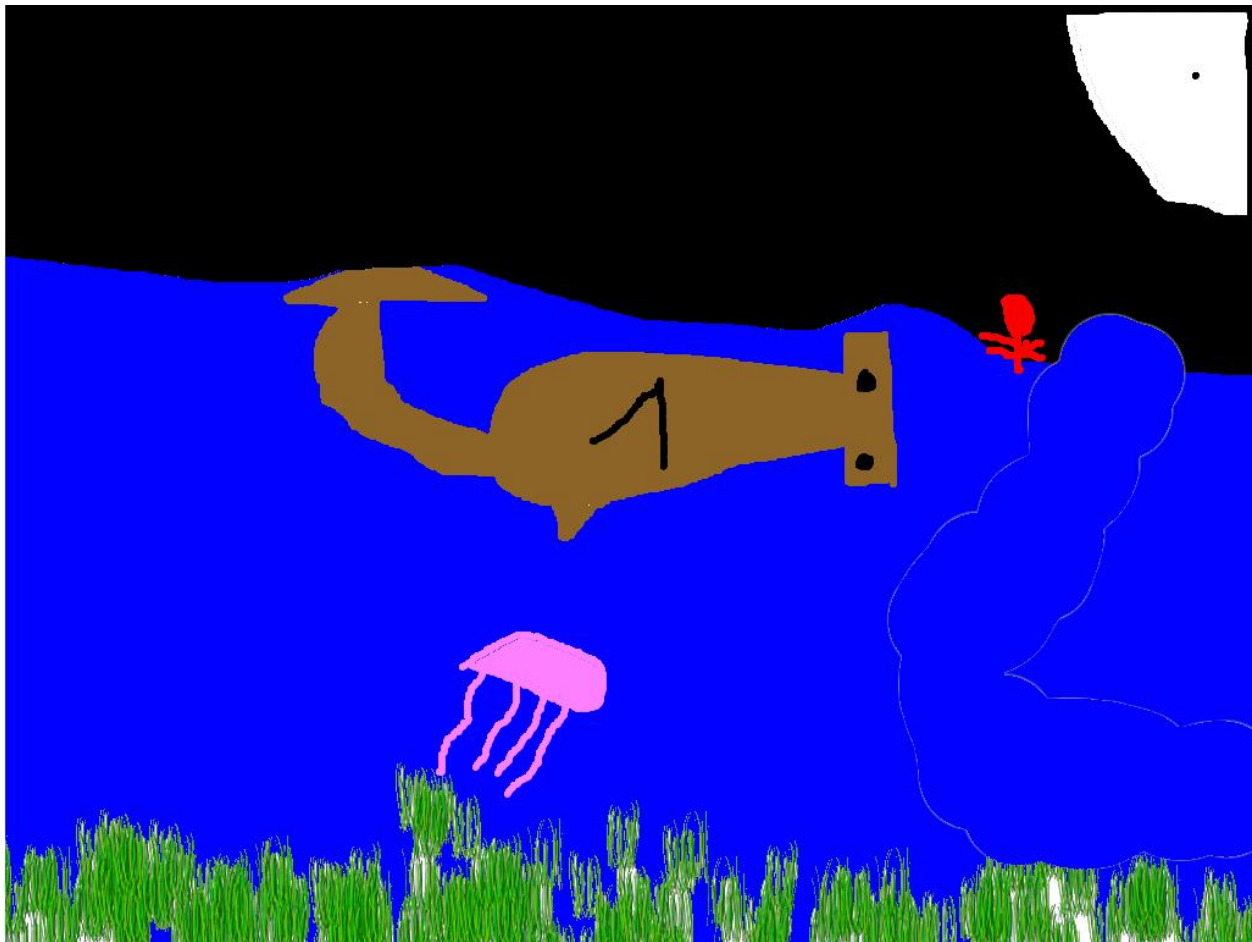
Amazing Hammerhead Shark
